The children have now settled nicely into our preschool routine and they are finally beginning to feel as though preschool is a special place for them to come to learn and play. Many of the children eagerly ask what craft we are going to be making next, and many of them can hardly wait until it is time for us to sing our monthly songs.

Christmas Theme

On December 16th we will be having a Christmas celebration. To start our celebration off, the children will perform a few short songs (about a 10 minute performance). We have purposely kept these songs simple and short as is appropriate for a three-year-olds attention span. Also note that because we have chosen to keep the Christmas celebration in our classroom (We have decided to do this because, this is the environment that is most familiar to your children. Given the stress that can sometimes go along with performing in front of large groups, we have tried our best to keep as many variables the same for them as we can.) there will be standing room only.

The program/celebration will take place a half an hour into preschool, **but still bring your children to preschool at the regular time** (parents and or other guests will come back to preschool a half an hour after the regular start time of your child's preschool class). Also just a heads up, please do not be disappointed if your child chooses not to participate in the program, as it can be very daunting for anyone, even an adult, to have to perform in front of a room full of people.

We want this program to be a new and exciting experience for your child, and not a stressful one. **Please carefully read your activity calendar to find out what time your child's program/celebration starts.**

On December 16th we are also asking that each family bring about a dozen pieces of Christmas baking to share with everyone at the celebration that will take place after the program, and as always please make sure that any and all items coming into our classroom are peanut and nut free. We thank you in advance for all of these baking items.



Preschool will provide the drink (juice/pop) for this. Furthermore, on that day if you would like to, you can bring one non-perishable item to donate to the food bank.
