

# **ILLNESS / COVID-19 AGREEMENT**

*(Revised March 2021)*

## **PARENTS AGREE TO KEEP THEIR CHILD/CHILDREN AT HOME OR SEEK ALTERNATE CARE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE CONDITIONS NOTED BELOW.**

Please note, for the health and security of all families we reserve the right to make assessments regarding children's health. As a preventative measure we may err on the side of caution within our assessment to avoid the spread of illness/disease. As an additional precaution Parents are asked that further testing be done through 811.

- Pain - any complaints of unexplained or undiagnosed pain or discomfort
- Fever (100°F/37.5°C or higher)
- Sore throat or trouble swallowing
- Headache or stiff neck
- Unexplained diarrhea or loose stool combined with nausea, vomiting or abdominal cramps.
- Nausea or vomiting
- Severe itching of body and scalp
- Known or suspected OR contact with a person who may have communicable diseases
- Children can return following a 24 hour symptom-free period

## **IT IS REQUIRED TO KEEP (OR TAKE) A CHILD HOME WHEN THE CHILD:**

- Is suffering from one or more of the above symptoms
- Is not well enough to participate in the activities of Summer in the Park.

## **ULTIMATELY THE CARE OF THE CHILD IS THE PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITY**

Parents will inform Summer in the Park Staff or the Rural Community Program Director/Designate within 24 hours of a diagnosis of a serious illness or contagious disease of a communicable nature in the family. This is to protect all families who attend Summer in the Park. Failure to do so is grounds for immediate termination of care. Parents agree that a child will be symptom free, without the aid of symptom reducing medications such as Tylenol, etc., for a full 24 hours prior to returning to Summer in the Park. We reserve the right to request a note from your family doctor or proof of test results depending on the illness/disease.
