

Pre-School is an important natural step for children to build upon their independence, socializations and skills for learning. Our 3 and 4 year old programs are still accepting registrations for our classes that operate 2 times a week from 9:00-11:30. We are a licensed program so access to the affordability grant and subsidy is available for families with a household income of up to \$180,000. Families who qualify for full subsidy will have their fees covered, if you do not qualify the parent portion fee is \$75/month. Schedule Changes for Your Calendars

It is important that we know which children to expect at OSCAR in order to ensure their safety and prevent missing children situations. Please remember that if notice of cancellation is not received by the OSCAR Director by noon on the day before, there shall be a minimum one-hour charge per day or day rate as per family contract. If no notice is given and a child does not arrive at the program as scheduled, a \$25 no-show fee shall be charged.

All schedule changes MUST be made by contacting the OSCAR Director by email, with advance notice. info@camroseoscar.ca or calling the OSCAR office at CDFCSS 780-672-0141. If there is no answer, please leave a detailed voicemail in regards to what you are calling about.

Changes

When sending an email, or leaving a voicemail, please include the following information:

- Childs full name
- Program location
- Reason for absence (if your child is ill I need to know as it is a licensing requirement)
- Date absent
- Time of the call

If your child is schedule to attend OSCAR and has joined an after school activity, it is VERY IMPORTANT that you notify the OSCAR Director/Office of the late arrival to the program after the sport activity. Scheduled children need to check in with the OSCAR staff before going to the activity. Once they check in, they go directly to the activity so they are not late.

Helpful tip

- Email your child's teacher to let them know when your child has OSCAR.
- Write in your child's agenda they go to OSCAR

Tooth decay is the most common, but preventable, childhood chronic disease both in Canada and around the world. Oral diseases frequently begin in the preschool years which is why it is so important to establish good oral hygiene behaviours as soon as possible.

The Government of Canada has implemented the interim Canada Dental Benefit, which is designed to provide some financial support to help Canadian families access dental care. With this benefit, families can start addressing some of the basic dental care that their young children need while the Government continues its work to develop a long-term Canadian dental care program.

WHAT is

The interim Canada Dental Benefit provides payments up to \$650 per eligible child under 12 years of age, per year for two years.

\$650

if the family's adjusted net income is under \$70,000

\$390

adjusted net income is between \$70,000 and \$79,999

\$260

adjusted net income is between \$80,000 and \$89,999

The benefit can be used for any dental care provided by any regulated dental professional.



WHO can apply?

Parents/Guardians who:

- Have a child under 12 years of age, who does not have access to private dental care insurance.
- Have an adjusted family net income under \$90,000 per year.
- Have filed last year's income tax return-for more information on how to file a return, visit Canada.ca/doing-vour-taxes.
- Receive the Canada Child Benefit for each eligible child.
- Have or will have dental care expenses for each eligible child that have not been fully reimbursed under another federal, provincial or territorial government program.



HOW can you apply?

Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) My Account will be the quickest, easiest and most secure way to apply for the Canada Dental Benefit. If you don't yet have a CRA My Account, you can register at Canada.ca/mv-cra-account.

You will need to provide information on the dental care visit, including the name of your child's dental care provider(s) and your employer information.

If you apply online and are signed up for CRA direct deposit, you can receive your payment within five business days!

If you're unable to apply for the Canada Dental Benefit online, call 1-800-715-8836 to get your application started.

Make sure you have your Social Insurance Number, address, date of birth and a copy of your income tax return from



WHEN can you apply?

Parents can now apply for dental care received by their eligible child back to October 1, 2022, so long as their child will still be under 12 on December 1. For the second benefit, parents can apply starting July 1, 2023.



WHAT if I don't read or speak English or French?

The application portal is only available in English and French. However, if you need help with the application, you can ask an English or French-speaking friend to sit with you while you fill out the application, or have them with you when you call 1-800-715-8836.

If you don't have a friend available to assist with the process, the CRA can arrange to call you back in order to have someone on the line who speaks your language.
